



## **Supportive Services for Veteran Families Program**

### ***What is the Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) program?***

- An intensive case management program offering assistance to Veterans to help them identify affordable and sustainable housing.
- The goal of the SSVF program is to promote housing stability among very low-income Veteran families who reside in or are transitioning to permanent housing through a wide range of supportive services.
- Eligible Veterans can receive temporary financial assistance for housing costs that include utilities, rent, and deposits required to move into housing.
- One80 Place provides these additional services directly or through targeted referrals:
  - Healthcare services
  - Daily living services
  - Personal financial planning services
  - Transportation services
  - Fiduciary and payee services
  - Legal services
  - Childcare services
  - Housing counseling services

***Service area:*** Beaufort, Berkeley, Charleston, Colleton, Dorchester, Hampton and Jasper Counties

### ***Who is eligible for SSVF assistance?***

- Veterans with a discharge status that is anything other than dishonorable.
- Must be currently homeless or at-risk of losing their permanent night-time residence.
- If the Veteran will become or remain homeless without assistance from SSVF, the Veteran may be eligible for assistance.

### ***Are there income requirements to be eligible for the SSVF program?***

- Applicants must be considered low-income. Please contact One80 Place for more information.
